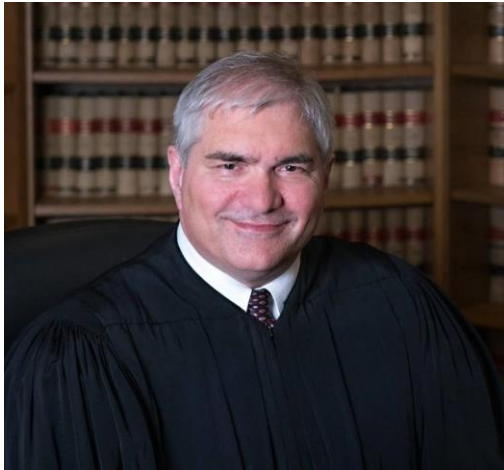


Federal Way Judge Dave Larson seeks Supreme Court seat

Federal Way Municipal Court Judge Dave Larson is seeking Position 6 on the Washington state Supreme Court this November.

The seat is currently held by Charlie Wiggins.

Larson has been a Federal Way judge since his appointment in 2008. He was re-elected in 2009 and 2013.

Before that, Larson served on the Federal Way School Board, the city's Human Services Commission and chaired its Board of Ethics.

Since 2010, Larson has been a faculty member at the Washington State Judicial College, teaching judicial independence and budgeting to incoming judges.

Larson is a 49-year resident of Federal Way who graduated from the University of Puget Sound in 1980 and the Seattle University law school in 1984.
